The fun begins with Greeting the Dawn on Saturday - May Day - at 5.15am. (come see and believe) in Wickham Square, followed by two concurrent tours on both Saturday and Sunday, to Portsmouth and the New Forest.

The Portsmouth Tour will include the Medieval festival at Fort Nelson at 10am, Churchillian PH on Portsdown Hill around 11am, Gunwharf Quays from 12 noon then the Historic Dockyard 2-4pm.

The New Forest Tour will be in Buckler's Hard from approx 10am, Master Builders PH over lunch and Exbury Gardens 2-4pm.

On May Day evening we will be back in Wickham Square for our traditional Evening of Dance when all our guest sides will be dancing after the evening has been launched by the Children's Maypole and Morris dancing at 6.30pm. A final Massed Dance around dusk will adjourn to a singaround at the Wheatsheaf PH in Shedfield (on the A334).

Sunday evening, 2nd May, will see a Barn Dance at Swanmore Village Hall, 8-11pm, with 'Red Hot Reeds' (and Ian Nichols calling, plus a Singaround in the adjoining Portal Room. Tickets (£5)
